## Assistance to Disadvantaged Communities

	<p><u>Habitat for Humanity</u> is a global nonprofit housing organization working in local communities across all 50 states in the U.S. and in approximately 70 countries.</p>
	<p><u>International Medical Corps</u> relieves the suffering of those affected by conflict, disaster and disease, often in difficult and dangerous environments.</p>
	<p><u>Hope Supply Co</u> provides critical needs of homeless and at-risk children across North Texas by providing necessities including diapers, wipes, hygiene kits, baby food and formula, clothing, school supplies and toys to enhance their lives.</p>
	<p><u>The North Texas Food Bank</u> provides more than 190,000 meals each day for hungry children, seniors, and families through a network of more than 1,000 programs and 200 Partner Agencies in their 13-county service area.</p>
	<p><u>New England Center and Home for Veterans (NECHV)</u> is a national leader in housing and serving Veterans who are at-risk of homelessness.</p>
	<p><u>Rosie's Place</u> is a multi-service community center that offers women emergency shelter and meals, a food pantry, ESOL classes, legal assistance, wellness care, one-on-one</p>

	<p>support, housing and job search services, and community outreach.</p>
	<p><u>Mid-Ohio Foodbank</u> distributes food and grocery products to more than 680 partner agencies (pantries, soup kitchens, shelters, etc.) in 20 central and eastern Ohio counties.</p>
	<p><u>Kaleidoscope Youth Center</u> is the largest and longest serving organization supporting LGBTQIA+ youth in Ohio.</p>
	<p><u>Crossroads Community</u> is an inclusive community that provides warm meals, healthy groceries, and safe shelter for New Yorkers from all walks of life.</p>
	<p><u>New York Community Trust</u> is the community foundation for New York City, with divisions in Westchester and Long Island. It is one of the oldest and largest community foundations in the United States and one of the largest funders of New York City's nonprofits.</p>
	<p>Organized by My Half of the Sky, <u>My Half Kitchen</u> employs local women who are overcoming trauma and hardship from human trafficking or life as a refugee.</p>
	<p><u>Bear Necessities</u> is a non-profit pediatric cancer foundation striving to brighten the lives of children with cancer.</p>
